Interested in learning more about Ohio's prehistoric artifacts, rocks, and fossils? The Ross County Historical Society--in conjunction with the Mound City Chapter of the Archaeological Society of Ohio, and Hopewell Culture National Historical Park--will host its second annual *Archaeology Day* on Saturday, April 22, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Featured will be more than 20 exhibits of locally and regionally-found prehistoric artifacts, geo-facts, fossils, minerals, rocks, and geodes. Many prehistoric items from the Historical Society's collections, including mammoth/mastodon tusks, teeth, and vertebrae, will also be on display for only the second time in recent years.
